# INSTRUCTION LEAFLET

## SAFETY NOTES:

- 1 This part should **ONLY** be fitted by suitably qualified persons having technical competence, applicable product knowledge and suitable tools and test equipment.
- 2 Servicing of electrical appliances must be undertaken with the appliance disconnected (unplugged) from the electrical supply.
- 3 Servicing must be preceded by Earth continuity and Insulation Resistance Checks.
- 4 Personal safety precautions must be taken to protect against accidents caused by sharp edges on metal and plastic parts.
- 5 After servicing, the appliance must be rechecked for Electrical Safety.

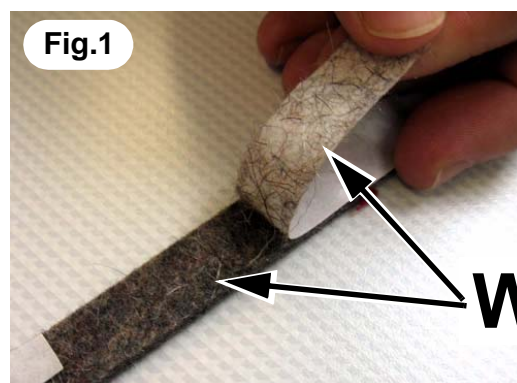
## REPLACEMENT FELT SEAL - ADHESIVE TAPE PREPARATION

### Please Note:

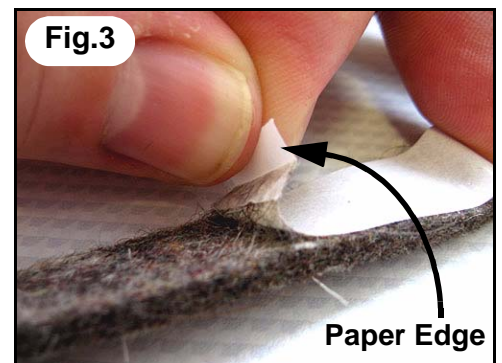
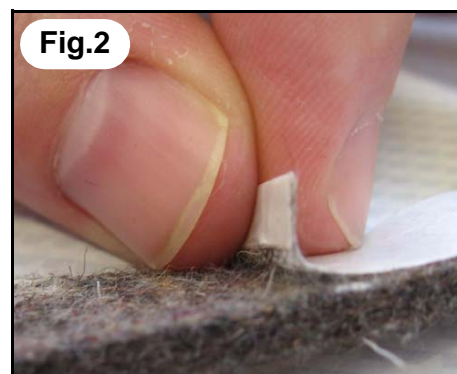
The enclosed Felt Seal has an adhesive tape backing. It is essential that **ONLY** the thin paper backing is removed and **NOT** the adhesive tape layer.

Fig. 1 Shows the **INCORRECT WAY**

Refer to the photographs below for the correct method of removing the paper.



1. Fold a short (8-10mm) section of the backing tape back onto itself and squeeze it to make a good adhesive fix. (Fig.2)
2. Carefully raise the edge of the paper backing to start off the peeling process for the backing paper. (Fig.3)



3. Press the raised adhesive strip back down on to the felt seal. Peel off all of the backing before fitting the seal. (Fig.4)
